

The best way to explore “HYDRA ISLAND”

The excursion will take place on Friday 2 September 2011. Those who wish to participate should be on the port just outside the Museum of Hydra - Archaeological Archive at 09:30 a.m. or join the second part of the tour that starts at 12:00 in front of ALPHA BANK.



*Our excursion will begin with a visit to the **Museum of Hydra-Historical Archives** on the port. The Museum hosts the permanent exhibition of heirlooms from the Balkan War and the World Wars I & II in the ground floor lobby. On the 1st floor one can find exhibits from ships taking part to the Greek Revolution as well as an outstanding collection of paintings from Greek and foreign painters, Hydrian costumes, weapons etc. The staircase is decorated with portraits of fire-rafters and sea fighters from Hydra. We will also have the chance to visit the contemporary*

exhibition- project “Eleventh Plateau”.

*We will continue our exploration by a **sightseeing tour** in the picturesque narrow streets and we will visit some of the town’s mansions with special character and history that were built in the late 18th century by Venetian and Genoese architects. Since Hydra is famous for the number of its churches and monasteries and several of them are well worth to see, we will continue our tour by visiting the most important ones with beautiful old domes, icons, wooden sculptures and temples.*



*12:00’ Embarkation on a “Sea Taxi” which will get us to the beautiful, small pebbled beach of “**Kamini**”. After swimming and sun bathing a very nice lunch will be waiting for us with in the restaurant “Castello”, with lots of Greek specialties, wine, beers and refreshments.*
